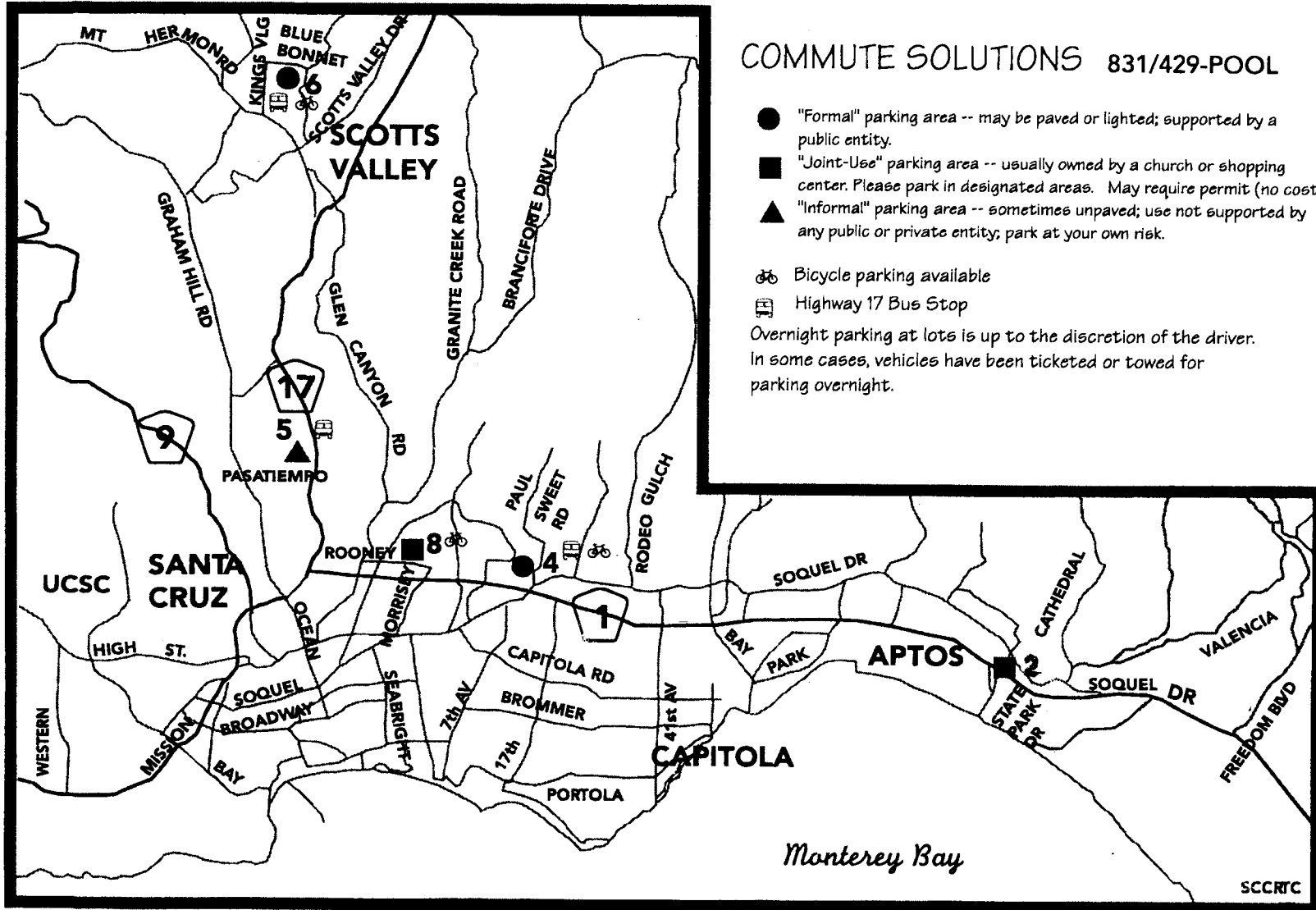


# PARK and RIDE lots in Santa Cruz County

Park and Ride lots are areas where you can park your car or bike - at no charge - to meet your carpool or vanpool or take public transit



COMMUTE SOLUTIONS 831/429-POOL

- "Formal" parking area -- may be paved or lighted; supported by a public entity.
- "Joint-Use" parking area -- usually owned by a church or shopping center. Please park in designated areas. May require permit (no cost).
- ▲ "Informal" parking area -- sometimes unpaved; use not supported by any public or private entity; park at your own risk.

Overnight parking at lots is up to the discretion of the driver. In some cases, vehicles have been ticketed or towed for parking overnight.

8. Quaker Meeting Hall, Santa Cruz (Highway 1 & Morrissey at 225 Rooney St.)
